ALL NTUC UNION MEMBERS TO ENJOY FREE ADMISSION INTO SENTOSA FROM 1 JULY

All NTUC union members will enjoy even more value-for-money getaways at Singapore's holiday island from 1 July 2019, following a three-year Partnership Agreement inked today between the National Trades Union Congress (NTUC) and Sentosa Development Corporation (SDC).

The Agreement signing was held together with the Family Day celebration at Sentosa, organised by the United Workers of Electronics & Electrical Industries (UWEEI).
